The wonder of Christian life begins with the reality of adoption. It is a word that gives us an identity. All of us are sons and daughters

of human parents. We have an identity which informs who we are, what we value, and how we act. Our human identity is broken by sin and division. We experience and cause division through our words and actions. Left to ourselves we need salvation.

In Jesus Christ, we receive adoption as sons and daughters of God. In Baptism, we die to the brokenness of sin and rise to new life in Jesus Christ. We receive a new identity, a son or daughter in Christ – we receive the dignity and inheritance of Jesus – that is why we are called Christians.

Our adoption is the result of the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross – he takes upon himself the burden of our sins. In this sacrifice he reconciles us to the Father. In doing so, he gives us the means to follow him, to become like Christ.

Our annual commemoration of Jesus' suffering, death, and resurrection – the Paschal Mystery – renews our identity as sons and daughters in Christ.
