On Saturday, June 22nd, Archbishop Coyne ordained two priests and two transitional deacons for the archdiocese. It is a beautiful and joyful day. One of the new priests (Rev. Daniel Hackenjos) has been assigned to New Britain and the other (Rev. Colin Lane) to

Wallingford. The two new deacons (Rev. Mr. Martin Chouinard and Rev. Mr. Mitchell Kendroioski) have one more year of seminary to complete and they will be ordained to the priesthood next year.

It is a privilege for me to be part of these ordinations as the director of Worship for the archdiocese. I help plan, rehearse, and oversee the Ordination Mass. It is exciting to be close to the wonder of the day and it is a powerful reminder of my own ordination day.

Please continue praying for vocations. The prayer after Mass, our own prayers, and the investment the archdiocese is making by dedicating Fr. Federico to vocation ministry is bearing fruit. We have five new seminarians starting in the fall and a large number of men (around 80) who are seriously discerning God's call.

Last weekend we were asked to fill out those "Called by Name" cards after Mass. Consider the people that are in your life and ask yourself if you think there may be someone who is called to be a religious sister or brother, a deacon, or a priest. Pray for that person and don't be afraid to ask them if they have thought about it. There is an amazing statistic that most priests report that someone asked them if they had thought about being a priest three to six times before they took the thought seriously. Building a culture of vocations to answer God's call requires us to pray, speak about it, and to invite.

O God, Who wish all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of Your truth: send, we beg You, laborers into Your harvest, and grant them grace to speak Your word with all boldness; so that Your word may spread and be glorified, and all nations may know You, the only God, and Him Whom You have sent, Jesus Christ Your Son, Our Lord, Who lives and reigns world without end. Amen.
