Words from Fr. Michael

The start of Holy Week invites us to meditate on the Passion of the Lord. The solemn proclamation of Jesus' suffering on Palm Sunday always jolts me. There is a stark power in hearing the passion read aloud without any breaks from the Last Supper to the burial. It is a lot to take in, even though

the narrative is familiar.

I encourage you to listen to the words of the passion this weekend and on Good Friday. Do not focus on what is familiar, listen to what stands out to you this year. Every time one hears scripture there is something new that God is saying to you. Pay attention to what sticks in your mind after hearing it. What detail, what phrase, what thought seems to come alive? Hold on to it for your prayer this week.

Keep in mind our Lord Jesus Christ's sacrifice for our redemption. This week is holy because it is the week that changes everything for the history of the world. God, in the flesh, suffers, dies, and rises out of love for us. Nothing is the same after this moment.

There are many opportunities for prayer this week. I wholeheartedly encourage you to come to the liturgies for the Triduum: Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. They will be power moments of worship. I also recommend coming to the celebration of Tenebrae at 7:00 pm on Palm Sunday evening. The service will include a meditative reading of the Passion according to Saint Matthew. It allows us to slow down and focus on hearing the Gospel.

Fr. Michael will be available this Monday to hear confessions from 5 to 6 PM. There will **not** be an opportunity for confession on Holy Saturday, April 19th.


